CLASS 1 - LESSON 2

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ

(I begin) in the name of Allah, the most Kind and the most Merciful.

We should say **بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ** before we do anything because we want Allah to help us in what ever we are doing.

If we say **بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ** then Allah keeps Shaitan away from us and he can not come and try to spoil what we are doing.

A long time ago there lived a woman who always used to say **بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ** before she did anything.

Now every night this woman, before she went to sleep would take off her ring and put it in her cupboard. And, as always, before she took off her ring she would say

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ

Her husband did not believe that just by saying

بِسْمِ اللّٰهِ الرَّحْمٰنِ الرَّحِیْمِ Allah would help you.

who says: **أَلَمْ يَكُنْ مِنْكُمْ مَنْ خَفَىٰ خَيْفًا**

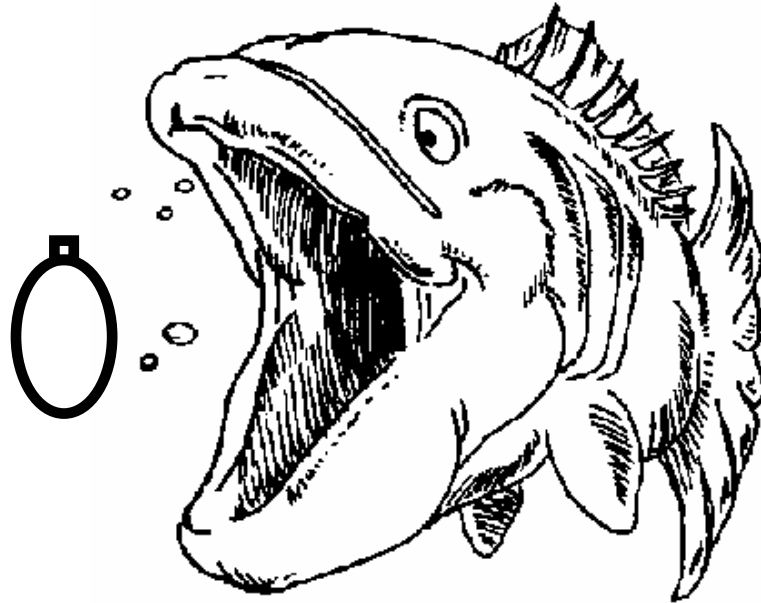
Moral:

The Prophets know everything and never ever do anything that Allah does not like.

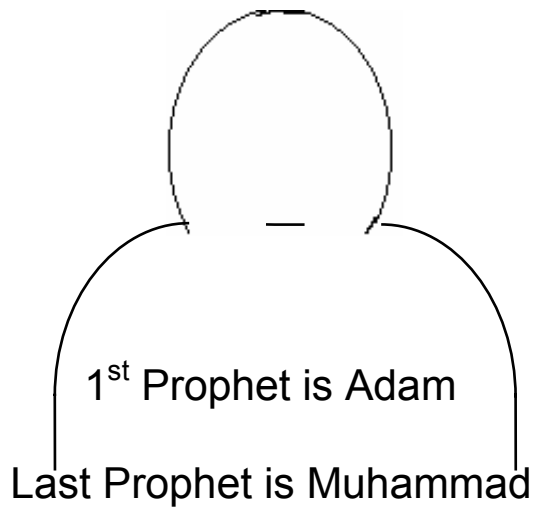
There have been lots and lots of Prophets (124 000).

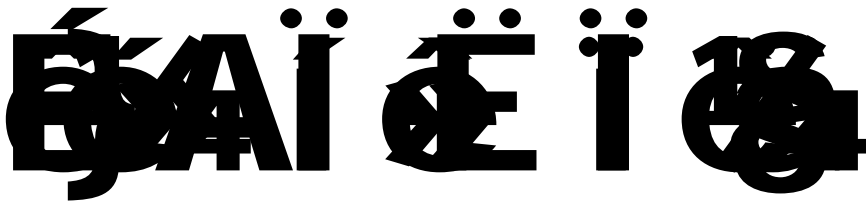

Imam Ali (A) is not a Prophet but an Imam. Our Holy Prophet, Prophet Muhammad (S) was the last Prophet.

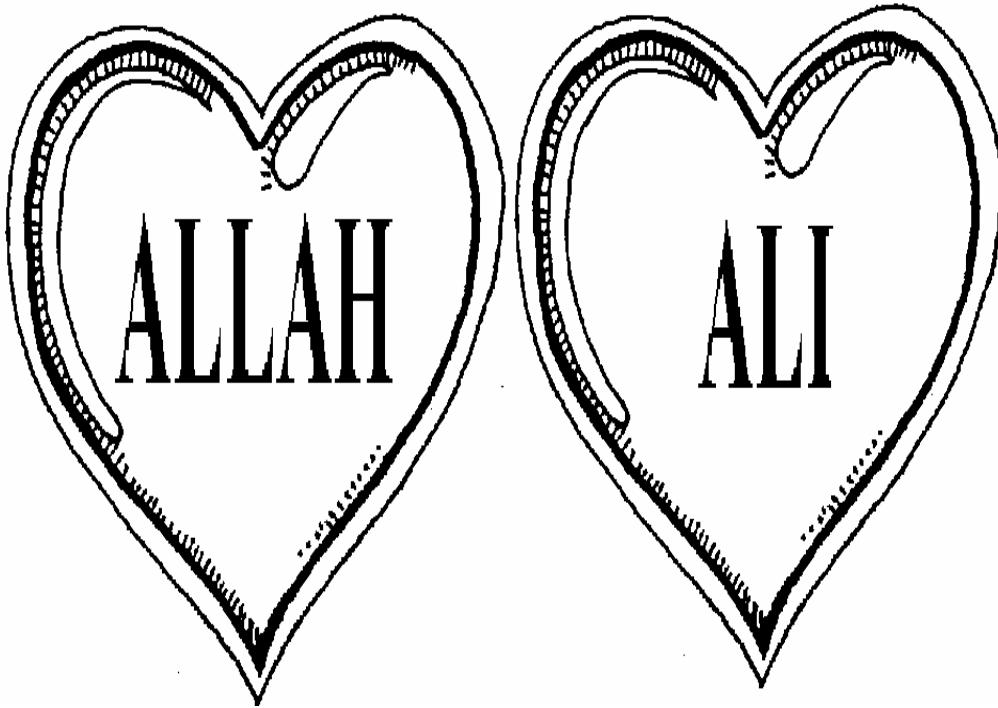

The first Imam was Imam Ali (A).

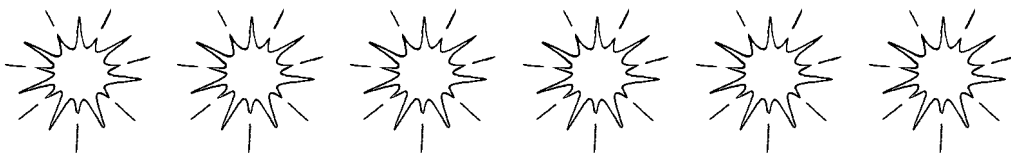
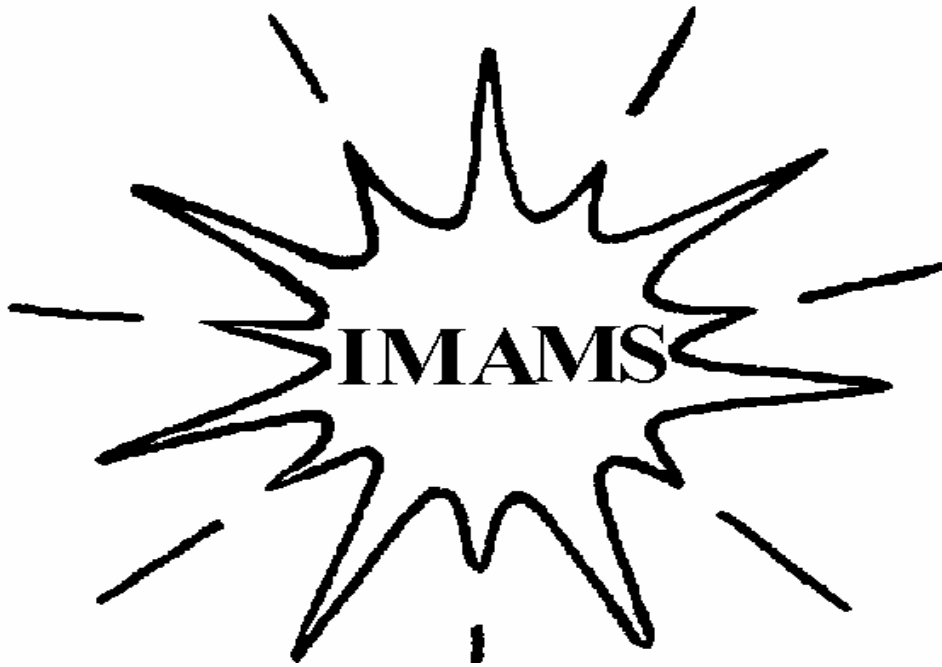
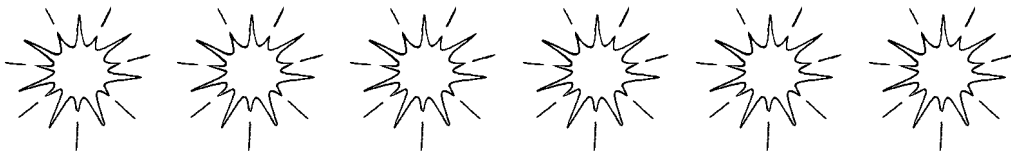
The last Imam is Imam Muhammad Mahdi (A). He is still alive and is the Imam of our time.

The good people all followed Imam Ali (A) and he always taught them how to be good Muslims and to make Allah happy.

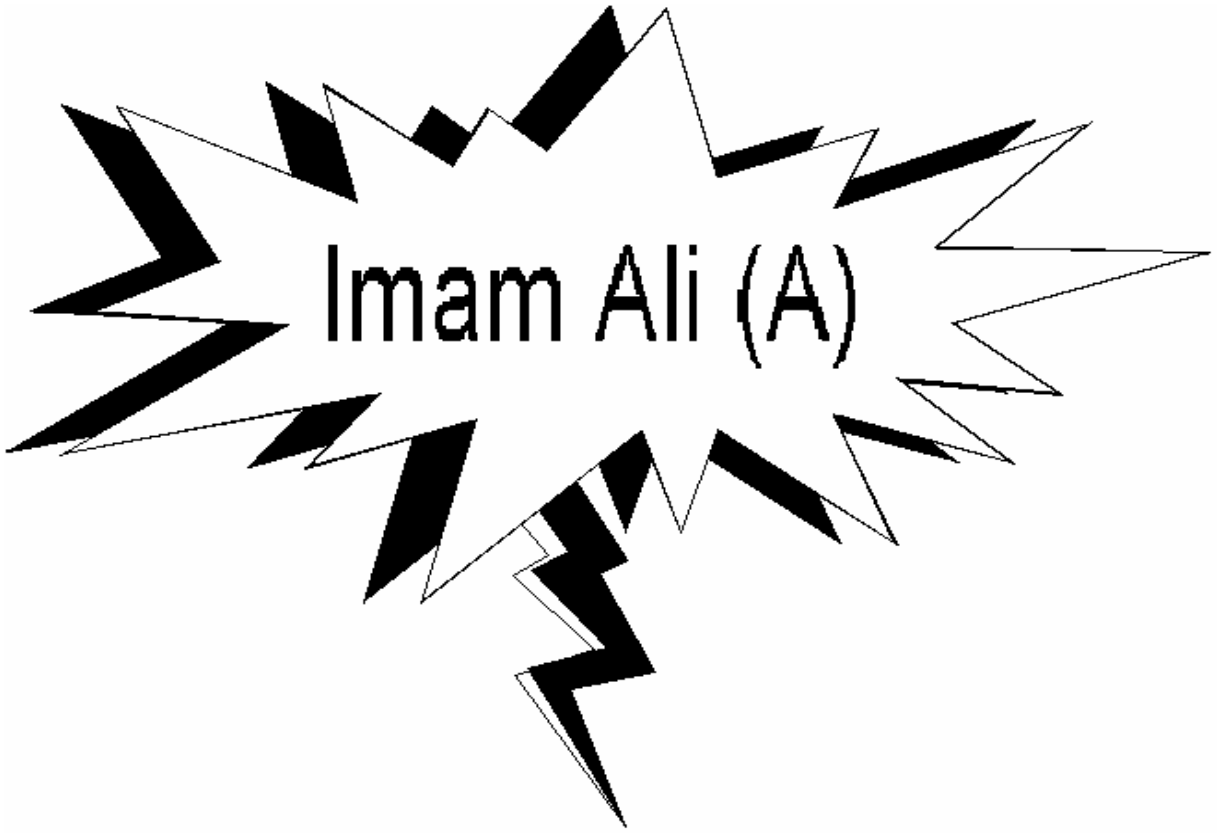
Imam Ali (A) was very clever and he taught the Muslims many things.

O Allah! Send Your blessings on Prophet Muhammad and his Ahlulbayt (family).

The family of the Prophet (S) are called his Ahlulbayt. They are his daughter Bibi Fatima (A) and the 12 Imams (A).

Whenever you hear the name of our Holy Prophet or his family you should say Salawaat.

When You hear the name of our 12th Imam, Imam Muhammad al-Mahdi (A) you should not only say Salawaat but stand up and put your right hand on your head and bow down your head. This is because our 12th Imam (A) is still alive.

When you are sitting in mosque and do not understand the talk, you should say as many Salawaat as you can.

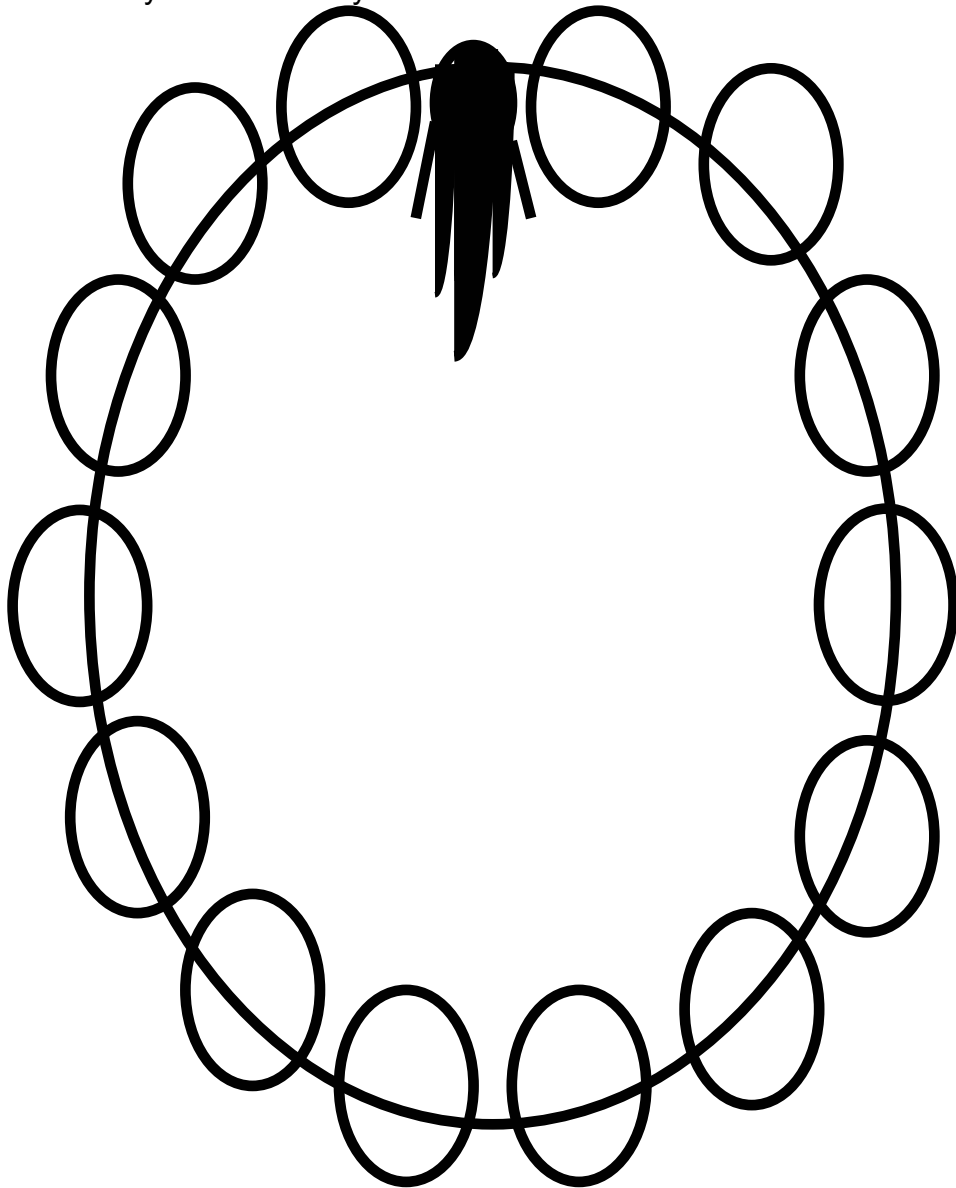
When you are saying Salawaat you are asking Allah to send His blessings to the Holy Prophet and his family and Inshallah on the day of Qiyama (Judgement) the Holy Prophet (S) and his family will ask Allah to forgive you in return for all the Salawaat you sent to them.

We all need Allah.

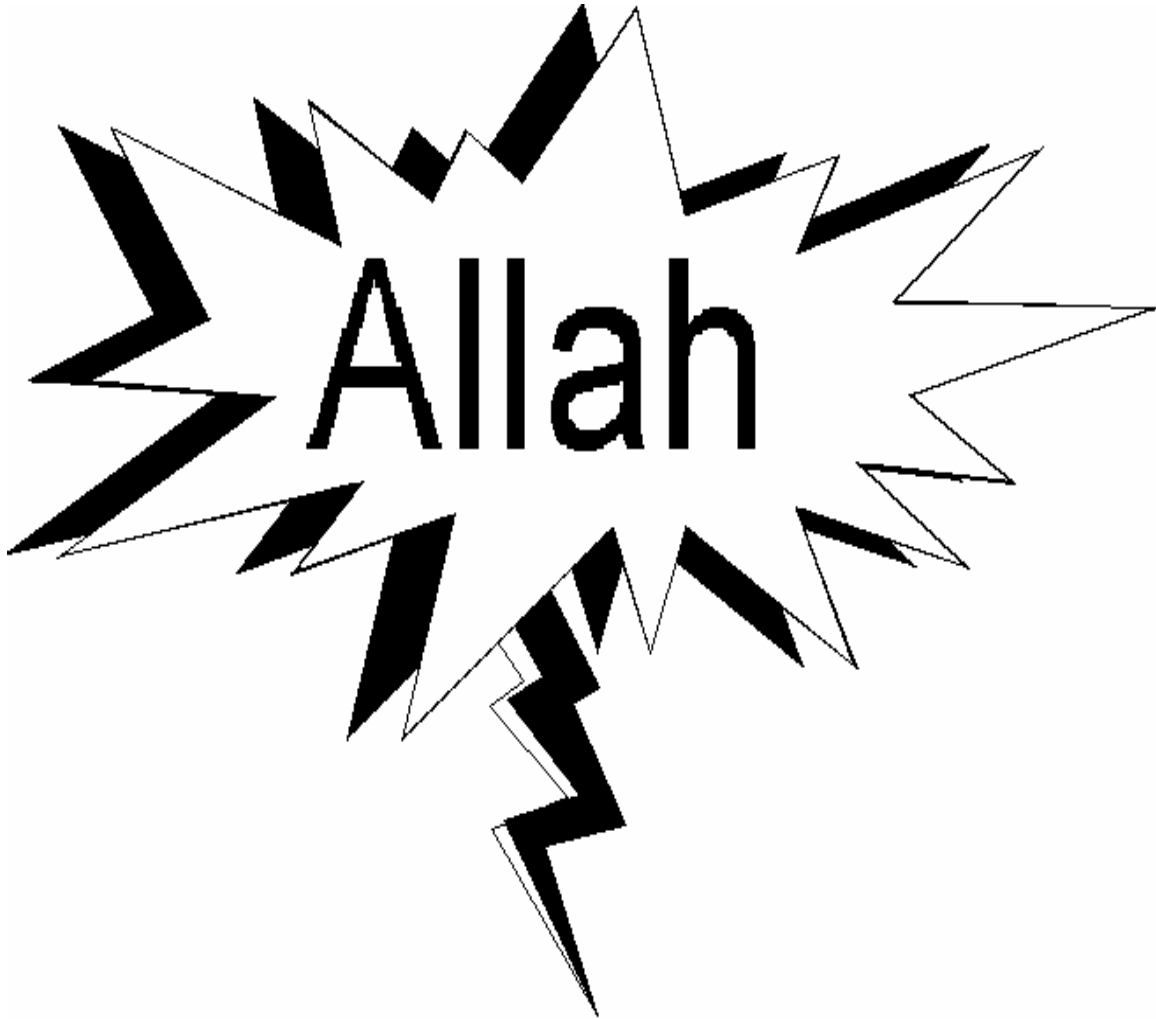

SALAAT

INTRODUCTION

Salaat is the daily Prayers that all Muslims pray, five times a day.

In Salaat you are talking to Allah, so you want to look your best. So it is better for you to wear nice, clean clothes. You yourself should also be nice and clean. Brush your teeth, brush your hair, just like you would if you were going to see someone important. Allah is more important than anyone, or anything.

Before Salaat you have to do Wudhu. This is a special way to wash yourself, that has been taught to us by our Holy Prophet, Prophet Muhammad (S).

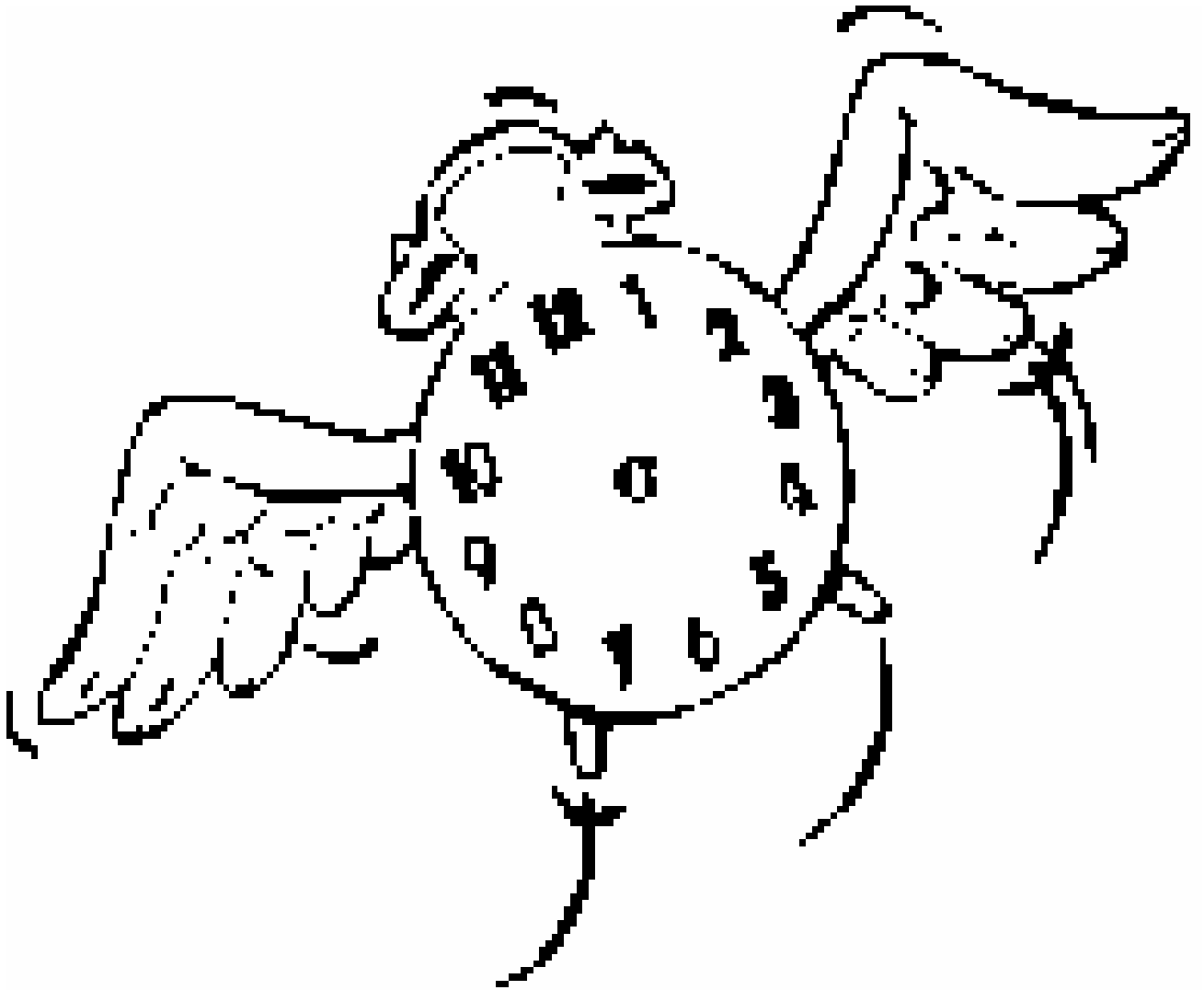
You can talk to Allah whenever you want, you do not have to wait till the time of Salaat.

Salaat is a way of talking to Allah that has been taught by our Holy Prophet, Prophet Muhammad (S). It is a special way, just like Wudhu is a special way of cleaning yourself.

When we pray Salaat we should think only about Allah and what we are saying in our Salaat, we should pray slowly and clearly, we should always pray on time, because we cannot wait to talk to Allah, because we love Him so much.

Qiyam is the special way that you should stand in Salaat.

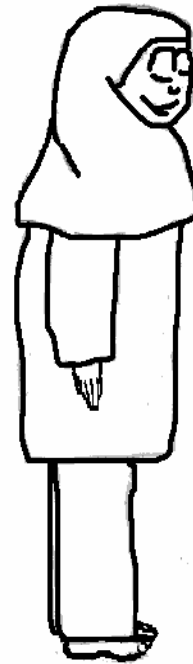

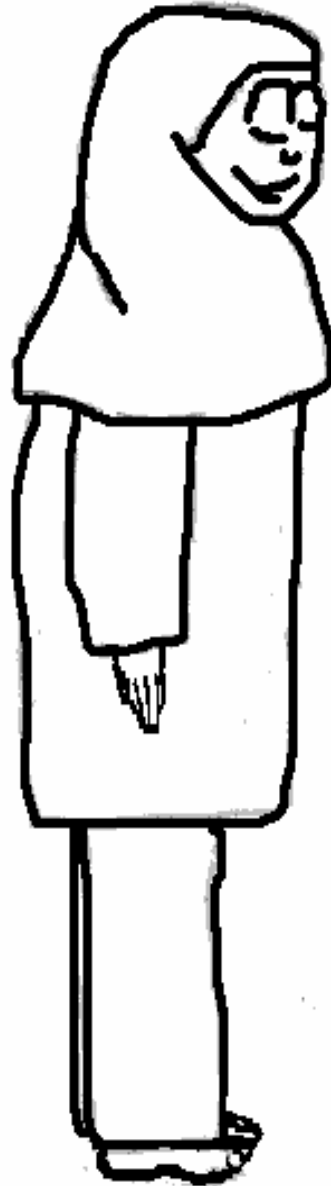

FIQH CLASS 1 - LESSON 14

SALAAT TAKBEERATUL IHRAM

To begin Salaat you must first be in Qiyam, then you have to do Takbeeratul Ihram.

Takbeeratul Ihram is the first Allahu Akbar that you say in Salaat. It is said after the Niyyat - what you are going to do and for whom.

As you are saying Takbeeratul Ihram, you have to raise your hands up, so that you thumb is behind your ear.

When you say this Allahu Akbar your Salaat has began.

Talib and his sister Taliba saying Takbeeratul Ihram:



TALIB:

- 1) Feet slightly apart
- 2) Hands up to the ear
(thumb behind ear)
- 3) Eyes looking down
(at the Mohr)



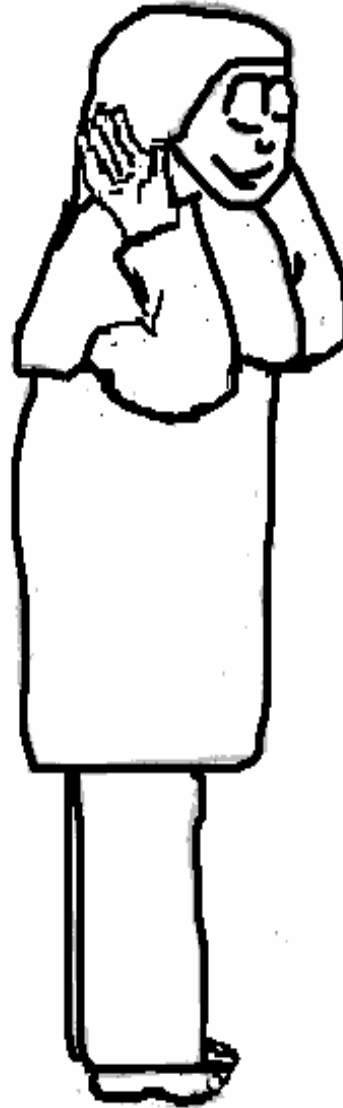
TALIBA:

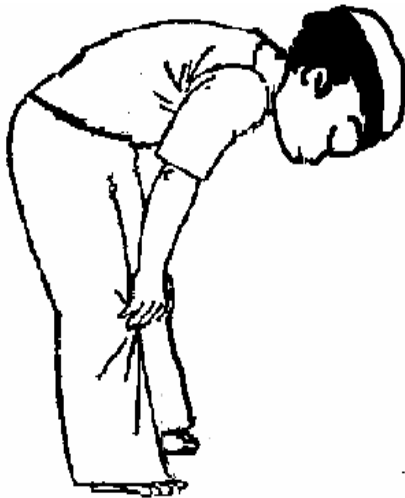
SALAAT - RUKU

Ruku is bowing, it is reached when you bend down from your middle.

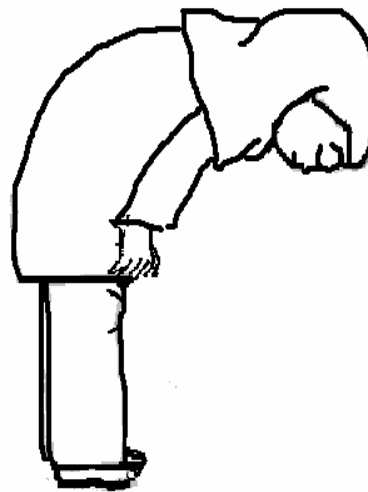
The Ruku for a boy and girl are different.

- 5) Keep his back flat

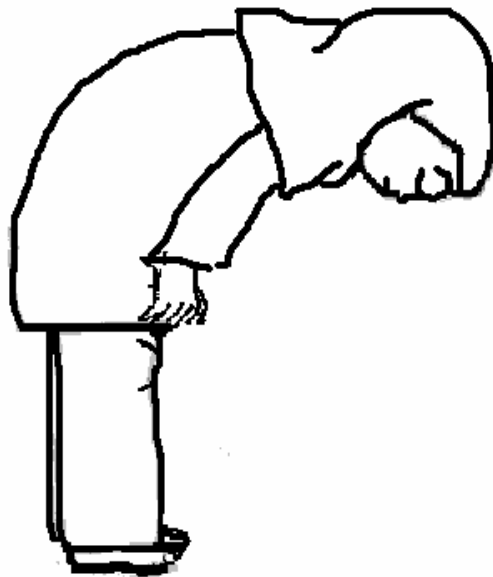
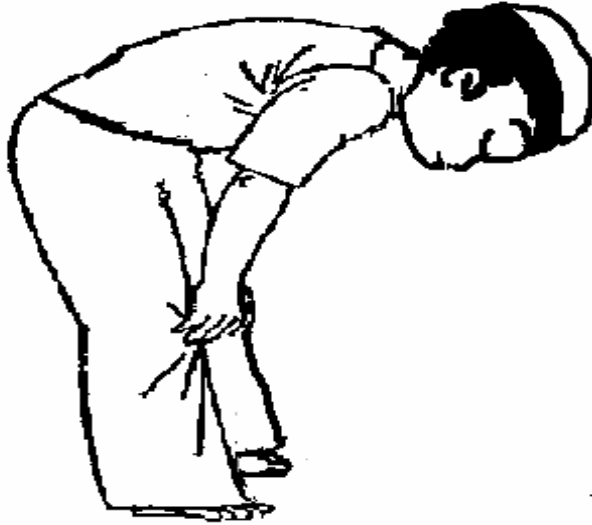

SALAAT - SAJDAH

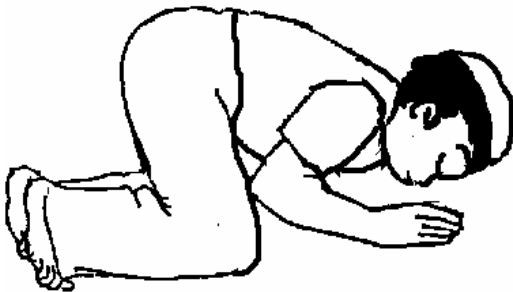
In Salaat after Ruku you do Qiyam, then Sajdah.

There are two Sujood in each Rakaat separated by Juluos.

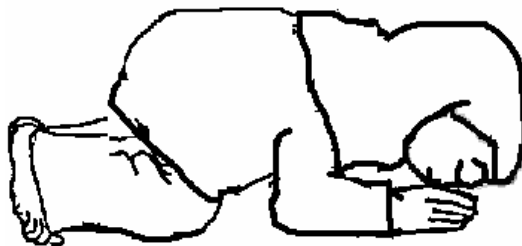
The Sajdah for a boy and girl are different.

(away from his side)

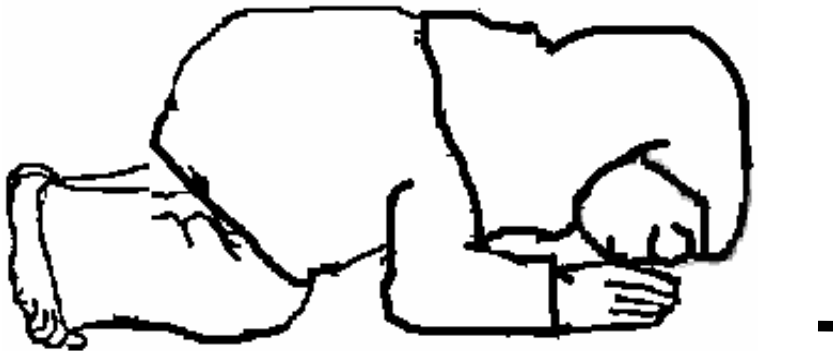

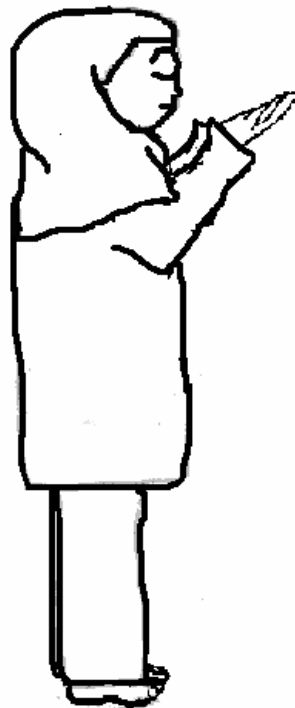
Qunoot is raising your hands up, with the palms facing the sky.

- 3) Eyes looking at the palms →

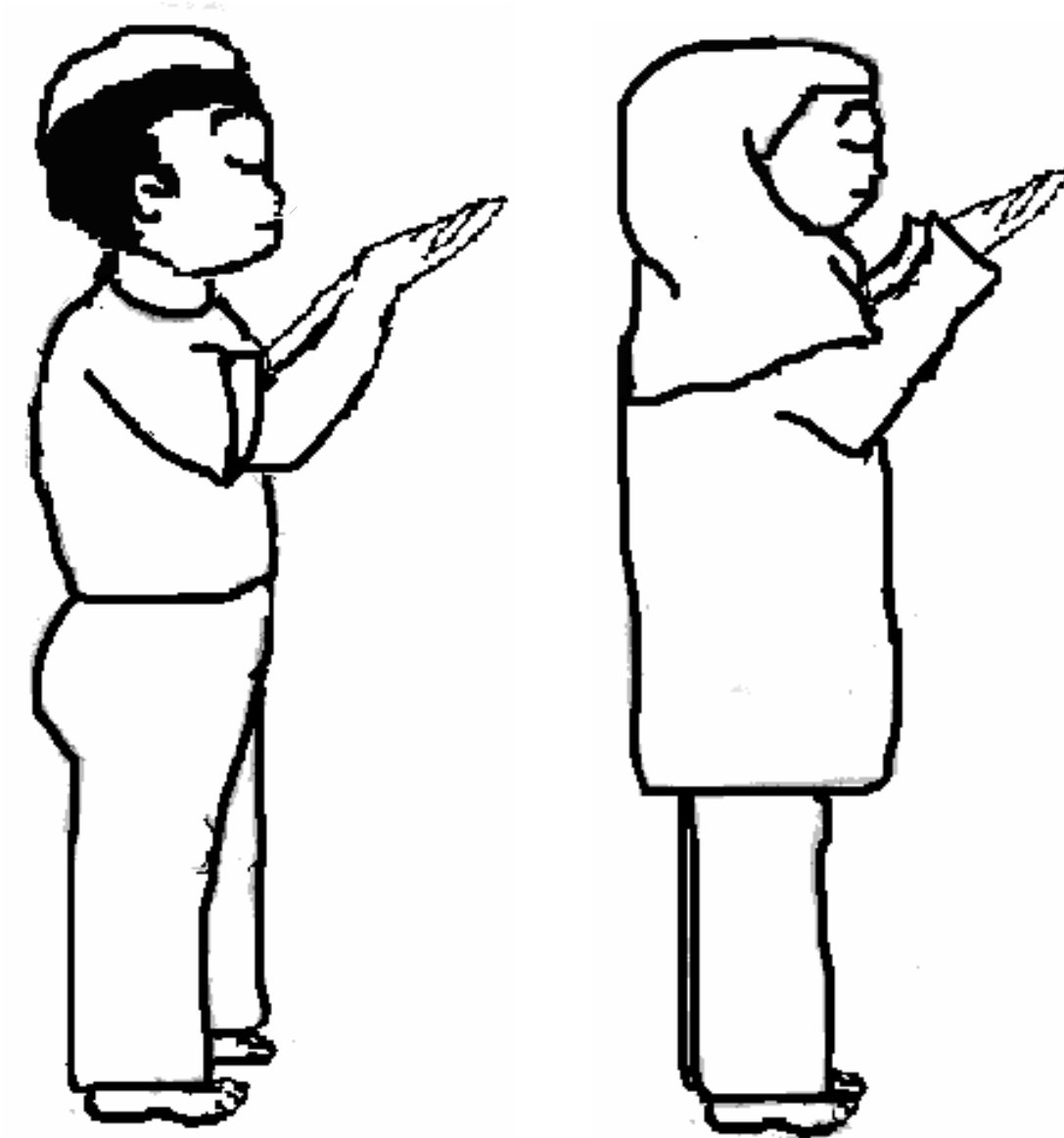
